Nurse Aide Training

75 hour training class for preparation to test for state certification exam.

Instruction includes:

- Communication skills
- Infection control
- Safety and emergency
- Resident independence
- Respecting residents
- Basic nursing skills
- Personal care skills
- Mental health issues
- Restorative care
- Resident rights

There is a total of 16 hours of orientation and instruction prior to resident contact.

There is an additional 59 hours of combined classroom and clinical experience. This includes 16 – 20 hours of resident care at a local long term care facility. There is a practice lab for learning and demonstrating skills.

- You must be at least 16 years old
- 2-step TB testing must be complete prior to first day of class

- Full refund is available prior to the first day of class. Partial refund is given during day 1 and 2, none thereafter
